Dear Benefit Eligible Employee,

Welcome to Open Enrollment 2025!

Open Enrollment is the only time during the year when you may review your benefit plan options and make desired changes for the coming year, including benefit elections and adding or removing dependents, without experiencing a qualifying event (such as the birth of a child or a marriage). It is also the time to enroll in the Health Care and/or Dependent Care Flexible Spending Accounts for next year.

Open Enrollment starts Monday, October 14, 2024 and runs through Friday, November 1, 2024

Plan Changes for 2025

PPO1, PPO2 and PPOHD medical plan benefits have coverage changes that may impact which plan best meets the needs of you and your family. The chart in the enclosed brochure explains differences between the medical plans and coverage updates going into effect January 1, 2025. Make sure to review this information carefully before the end of the Enrollment period.

Do I need to Enroll for 2025?

Not if you are happy with your current elections. Active enrollment is encouraged but not required for 2025. If you do not participate in Open Enrollment, your current benefit elections **except Flexible Spending Accounts** will carry over into 2025. Flexible Spending Accounts require an active enrollment every year.

Changes made during Open Enrollment go into effect January 1, 2025.

You can learn which benefit plans your employer offers when enrolling online, by calling the MCC Benefits Team, or by checking with your employer. Be sure too to ask your employer about any cost share amounts for which you may be responsible for medical, dental and/or vision coverage for yourself and family members.
